3. Maximum limit of 300 words
4. Set-out must contain the following headings:
Aims, Methods, Results, Conclusions.

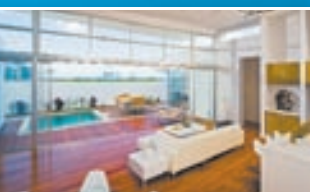
